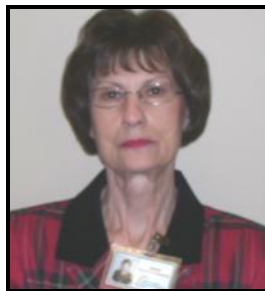

CCMH Honors Staff for Years of Service

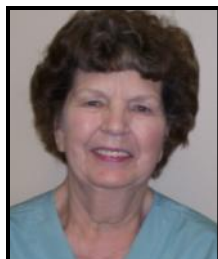

15 Years of Service—Nicole Renick

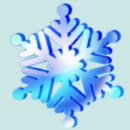

10 Years of Service—Michael Collins

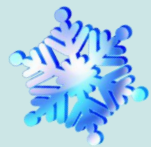

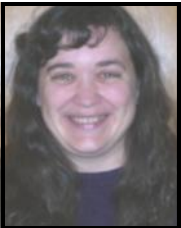
5 Years of Service—Traci Guinn
